Is my eyesight fading or am I just imagining it,
am I going to get rheumatism, lockjaw, dementia?

Finally I saw that worrying had come to nothing

And gave it up. And took my old body

And went out into the morning, and sang.

And so, needing to travel up to Grace for VBS, I took my old body out into the late afternoon, got in my car, pulled up Setting Eight on my phone and sang – all the way to Prosperity!


