Dear Family,

It's time to get my newsletter article to Julie, but today I find my heart and head too full of other things to be creative. This morning we just learned of the death of Mr. Edd - a saint/sinner of God's own redeeming. A funeral to come later this week - and so I turned to my files and found this prayer written by Oscar Romero, archbishop of San Salvador, assassinated while presiding at mass in the chapel of a hospital. I read it often. I pray it often. I hope it speaks to you this month.

It helps, now and then, to step back and take the long view.

The Kingdom is not only beyond our efforts; It is even beyond our vision. We accomplish in our lifetime only a tiny fraction of the magnificent Enterprise that is God's work Nothing we do is complete... Which is another way of saying that The Kingdom always lies beyond us. No statement says all that should be said. No prayer fully expresses our faith. No confession brings perfection. No pastoral visit (or lay visit) brings wholeness. No program accomplishes the church's mission. No set of goals and objectives includes everything. This is what we are about... We plant the seeds that will one day grow. We water seeds already planted, Knowing that they hold future promise. We lay foundations that will need further development. We provide yeast that produces effects far beyond our capabilities. We cannot do everything. And there is some sense of liberation in realizing that. This enables us to do something - and to do it well. It may be incomplete, but it is a beginning, A step along the way, An opportunity for the Lord's grace to enter and do the rest. We may never see the end results, But that is the difference Between the master builder and the worker. We are workers, not master builders. Ministers (lay and ordained), not Messiahs. We are prophets of a future that is not our own. We pray this in Jesus' name.







Building Loan Update

After the proceeds from the sale of the Hwy. 76 property were applied to the loan principal, the Ministry Center building loan balance is down to about \$48,643 as



of Oct. 2 - reduced from more than \$195,000 at the beginning of 2023.

With a small increase in our giving to the Building Fund over the next three months and with the about \$32,000 already in the Building Fund reserves, we should be on track to pay off the Ministry Center loan by the end of 2023!

Council Meeting - Tuesday, Sept. 12



Council On Aug. 22, Council voted via email on a recommendation to the congregation to sell the Quattlebaum property and apply the proceeds to the Building Fund Loan. The recommendation was passed unanimously at the congregational meeting held Sept. 10. Robert is helping with execution of the contract for sale.

Pastor Rick Carter met with the Wake Up Team prior to the Council meeting and stayed to discuss questions with Council about next steps for exploring partnership, including identifying possible partner churches and outlining Grace's desires for an agreement.

Council discussed a need for updates to the time and talent form to reflect current activities at the church. The need to review the roster of inactive members was brought up, and Pastor Jane planned to draft an option for an outreach letter.

All reports were adopted unanimously. Beverly drafted a position description for the administrative secretary position, which was approved to be posted on iob boards.

Related to finances, the Spotts' gift funds were transferred to a Money Market account since the last Council meeting. Several council members are still exploring options for an accountant who could take on Current Fund treasurer duties. Related to facilities/technology, telephone service with Carolina Connect has been completed. Beverly is continuing to explore livestreaming options. Robert assessed the condition of the parsonage and felt it would need significant upgrades to be usable. The Facilities Team has been repainting outdoor signage.

The Good News Team reported plans for a t-shirt fundraiser. Grace also planned to put a DVD with its church history in the Prosperity town time capsule.
