From Our Interim



"Will the defendant please rise?' Judge I.M. Pilate said as the results of the jury decision were handed to him. The question before the jury was this, "Is God's grace sufficient, even for Judas?" And the verdict: "Guilty, but forgiven. You are free to go, Mr. Iscariot!"

This Lenten season we have been challenged by this Lenten drama to ponder our own sinfulness and the depth of God's grace. And in those words, guilty but forgiven, we hear the good news of the gift to us of God's resurrection promise. Yes, we are guilty – all of us – each of us – of sin. Some sins we unknowingly commit. Some sins we knowing commit. And some sins we commit by omission. As St. Paul says in Romans 7, "… For I do not do what I want, but I do the very thing I hate…" It's not always easy inwardly, outwardly or sincerely to confess that we are sinners, that we have sinned against God and against one another and yet that's what our Lenten journey has been about. And that journey culminates for us on Good Friday when we see the cost of our sin as Jesus lovingly and freely dies so that our sins might be forgiven. And there's that "guilty" part. But then, thankfully, out of the loving and grace-filled heart of God, through the death and resurrection of God's beloved Son,, comes those healing words, "…but forgiven." We call that GRACE – not earned, but given - given from the very heart of God because God so loved the world.

In John's gospel, at the tomb on that first Easter morning, Mary Magdalene encounters the gardener, or at least that's who she thinks he is; that is, until he speaks her name. And then she knows. And she runs and tells the other disciples, "I have seen the Lord..." And with that proclamation, guilty, but forgiven is sealed for all believers forever. That's the Easter message to us! Christ is risen! Death could not hold him – and because He lives, we live also!

But then what? Is that it until next Lent and Easter? Sadly, for too many, it is. But not for those who strive faithfully to follow in the footsteps of this One whose love for humankind is beyond our understanding. We are called, like Mary, to go and tell the others, "I have seen the Lord!" And because I have seen the Lord, my life is forever changed. Do you remember one of my models for sermon writing? It goes like this. What did the scripture say then? What does it say now? And, so what? And that "so what" is now our Easter mission - telling, better yet showing, this story of Jesus and his love in some way to someone every day. Luther calls this "because-therefore theology" – because God has done this for us: therefore, we respond by loving God and loving neighbor as we have first been loved.

And that's not easy! Especially when we remember that we are to love as Jesus loved – the poor, the outcast, the unloved, the unnamed, the doubter, the unbeliever. But we never walk this path alone. First of all, our empowerment comes from the Holy Spirit implanted in us at baptism. Next, we live together in a community of faithful believers who walk the path with us – both in empowering us to model Jesus and to carry us when we can't.

That, my dear friends, is the Easter message – and the Easter mission. Guilty, but forgiven. Redeemed and claimed as a follower of the risen Christ, we live out our faith for the sake of the gospel in the world. What a joy it is to be called to be faithful disciples!

#### God at Work

**Many thanks** to all those who participated in this year's Lenten worship, "*The Trial of Judas... the punishment phase*" written by Clayton McCord and first published in 1999. Each afternoon in Lent, about 45 worshippers gathered to worship, to hear the witnesses testify, and to decide this question: "Is God's grace sufficient—even for Judas?"

### THE VERDICT IS IN

On Sunday, March 17, the trial of Judas Iscariot concluded with powerful arguments by both defense and prosecutor attorneys. The jury voted. The trial ended and the verdict rendered was this:

-Guilty, unforgiven - 1 -Guilty, but forgiven - 36 -Not guilty, it was his role -8

Judge I. M. Pilate pronounced Judas "not guilty" and free to go.

The following comments were also noted on a few ballots:

-God's mercy is for all! -God forgives all sin! -I am not free from sin. -The God I know and love is a forgiving God. -FREE JUDAS! -Judas was pre-scheduled for his role; however, he never believed Jesus to be the Christ!

### Lutheroad Day Camp July 15-19




Once again, Grace is partnering with Mt. Tabor, Mt. Pilgrim,
